## ARCHBISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL BEGINS NEXT WEEKEND

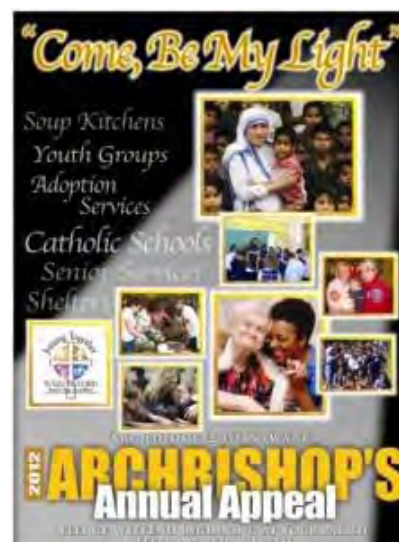


*"How shall I make a return to the Lord for all the good He has done for me?"*

## From the Pastor's Desk



Thursday, we celebrate our feast day, the Presentation of the Lord in the temple. Take a moment to notice our stained glass window in the choir loft, which depicts our feast day. We see the beautiful figures of Simeon and Anna, who are waiting day by day in the temple to receive the promised Messiah before they die. Surprisingly, instead of Brad Pitt out of central casting, Mary and Joseph and the infant Jesus arrive. This is the one! Wow!

I'm happy to report that monies received during the Christmas season totaled \$252,435. This season represents our largest collection of the year and certainly drives our budget. Your generosity is very much appreciated.

Next weekend, we'll kick off the Archbishop's Annual Appeal. This is the fund that allows us to continue the mission in this area of the world. AAA helps underwrite Catholic Charities, schools, outreach programs, seminaries, central services, which advise all the parishes, and residences for retired priests. At next weekend's Masses, I'll invite all of you to participate. It's always good to know we're part of a bigger effort. Our goal this year is \$122,000. I'm happy to report that for the last five years, we've exceeded our goal because of your good stewardship. Because of exceeding last year's goal, we received a rebate check last week from the Archdiocese in the amount of \$18,800. The timing couldn't be better because one of our two 25-year old boilers which heat our parish just failed for good. Many thanks to our parishioners who own Hughes Environmental Engineering (in Montvale, NJ). They're installing the new boiler for us at a tremendous savings because of their good stewardship.

Speaking of good stewards, Rich Stewen, who works in construction, has helped our men's volunteer group fix a lot of our auditorium chairs, giving them several more years of life and helped us with our water and drainage in our baptistery. Congratulations on his marriage to Christienne this afternoon!

Please note that next Sunday's 6:30pm Mass is being moved to 5:00pm. Past experience has taught us that mass attendance during the Super Bowl is virtually nonexistent! Go Giants!

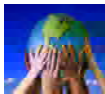

**"FRANKly" Speaking- We're Getting Warmer**

The global average temperature in 2011 was the ninth-warmest in the modern meteorological record, continuing a trend linked to greenhouse gases that saw nine of the ten hottest years occurring since the year 2000, NASA scientists said. These high global temperatures come even with the cooling effects of a strong La Nina ocean temperature pattern and low solar activity for the past several years. The NASA statement said the current higher temperatures are largely sustained by increased concentrations of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere, especially carbon dioxide. Carbon dioxide is emitted by various human activities, from coal-fired power plants to fossil-fueled vehicles to human breath.

Last year was also a year of record-breaking climate extremes in the United States, which contributed to fourteen weather and climate disasters with economic impact of \$1 billion or more each. This number does not count a pre-Halloween snowstorm in the Northeast, which is still being analyzed.
