## **Hail Holy Queen (Salve Regina)**

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of Mercy. Our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To you do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. # CHAPLET TO THE DIVINE MERCY

## Opening Prayer

**All:** You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and an ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us. I trust in You! (*three times*)

*(The Chaplet is prayed using the 5-decade Rosary)*

On the Our Father beads say the following:

**Leader:** Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ.

**All:** In atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the 10 Hail Mary beads say the following for 5 decades:

**Leader:** For the sake of His sorrowful passion.

**All:** Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

*After 5 decades, conclude with:*

**All:** Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (*three times*)

## Closing Prayer

**All:** Eternal God, in whom Mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your Holy Will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.

Who live and reign with God the Father in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

**All:** Amen.

**Priest:** Let's all recite the following praises together.

Blessed be Jesus Christ, true God and true man.

Blessed be the name of Jesus.

Blessed be his most Sacred Heart.

Blessed be his most Precious Blood.

Blessed be Jesus in the most holy sacrament of the altar.

Blessed be the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete.

Blessed be the great Mother of God, Mary most holy.

Blessed be her holy and Immaculate Conception.

Blessed be her glorious Assumption.

Blessed be the name of Mary, virgin and Mother.

Blessed be St. Joseph, her most chaste spouse.

Blessed be God in his angels and in his saints. Amen.
