

#### FROM THE PASTOR

The most important week of the Church year begins, when we celebrate everything we hold true and sacred. On Holy Thursday, we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood. On Good Friday, we celebrate Jesus' Passion and venerate the symbol of his sacrifice for our salvation. At the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday, we begin with a bonfire on the lawn, the scripture readings celebrate our history of salvation and we receive our new members into the Church. Because of Easter, our greatest feast, death no longer has a grip, and nothing has been the same since!

All of our Holy Week offerings are on the cover, with some highlights below:

- † The **Easter Mass Schedule** is different than the regular Sunday Mass schedule. *See the cover*.
- † **Pardon & Peace**, 7:00pm on Tuesday. What a great way to enter the week.
- † Morning Prayer, Thursday, Friday & Saturday mornings at 9:00am. During these three days, the Eucharist is suspended except for the evening services of the Triduum. Morning Prayer is a wonderful experience of music, psalms and reflections given by some lay members of our community.
- † **Holy Thursday**, the Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30pm, followed by adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 11pm.
- <sup>†</sup> **Good Friday**, weather permitting, Bicycle Stations after Morning Prayer; celebration of the Lord's Passion with veneration of the cross at 3:00pm & our Youth Ministry's Living Stations at 7:30pm.
- <sup>†</sup> **The Easter Vigil**, don't be afraid of it! It's one of the most exciting moments of the year, a great teaching tool for our families, and a great celebration welcoming new members into our faith.

# Sunday, March 24, 2024 Never Alone

Today's readings: Gospel at the procession Mark 11:1-10 or John 12:12-16; Isaiah 50:4-7; Psalm 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24; Philippians 2:6-11; Mark 14:1-15:47. Today's readings leave us much to ponder. During the Gospel at the procession, a crowd welcomes Jesus to Jerusalem, singing, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" At the end of the Gospel from Mark, Jesus was not hailed but reviled as passersby taunted, "You who would destroy the temple in three days, save yourself by coming down from the cross."

In the last verses from Mark's Gospel, we witness the faith of the steadfast disciples, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of younger James and Joses, and Salome. These women had followed Jesus in Galilee, stood by until his

death, and watched where he was laid in a tomb. Apparent, too, is the faith of Joseph of Arimathea, who wrapped Jesus in linen and laid him in the tomb.

Also obvious in the Gospel is the wavering faith of those who had followed Jesus for three years. Not only did Judas betray Jesus, but Peter could not stay awake with him as he prayed in the garden, and later Peter denied him three times. The Gospel proclaimed today does not record the apostles' presence at the crucifixion.

During Holy Week, Christians have the opportunity to be with Christ as his last days are recalled. Take to heart Jesus' words to the apostles in Gethsemane: "Remain here and keep watch."
