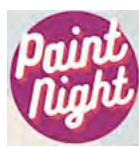

## FROM THE PASTOR

As I write this, the **Conclave in Rome** is just beginning, so we pray for the Cardinal Electors as they decide who the next pope will be. By the time you read this, he may already be named. We pray for him and the heavy responsibilities he will have to bear. However, at the end of the day, it's Jesus Christ at the center of His Church no matter who the next pope is.

**Last week, I was in Rome on our pilgrimage** and was thrilled to be able to say Mass at St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. During previous pilgrimages, I've said Mass on the 2nd level at one of the many altars in the crypt. This time I was able to celebrate Mass at the Altar of the Chair of St. Peter. (the large altar at the end of the long center aisle). It was both humbling and exhilarating to celebrate under Peter's Chair (designed by Bernini) which overlooks the altar. It made me want to get all my theology correct! I was also able to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis of Assisi, in Santa Croce in Florence (where so many Italian worthies have been buried), and in St. Catherine of Siena's old church on her feast day (where parts of her body remain). Wonderful experiences I was blessed to have!

**Happy Mother's Day!** What a fitting day to honor our Blessed Mother with May Crowning at the 10:00am Mass today. We wish all our moms the best

of the day and we thank God for all the women in our community who do so much to nourish us, heal us and call forth our gifts.

The Easter Season continues with new life! **Congratulations to those visiting the Eucharistic table** for the first time this weekend; and congratulations also to our teens who will be celebrating **Confirmation** with Bishop Saporito next Saturday.

I'm happy to report that the **Annual Appeal** has raised \$184,000 donated by 423 households. We're almost at our goal of \$196,624! Let's keep going!

## Fourth Sunday of Easter



### Instruments of Salvation

God our Light,  
your kindness endures forever.

### Sunday, May 11, 2025 Shake the Dust from Your Feet

*Today's readings: Acts 13:14, 43-52; Psalm 100:1-2, 3, 5; Revelation 7:9, 14b-17; John 10:27-30.* Today, we hear that Paul and Barnabas reach Antioch. They proclaimed the Word of the Lord and exhorted many Jews and worshipers who were converts to Judaism "to remain faithful to the grace of God." A week later, the city gathers to hear the word of the Lord. Upon seeing the massive crowds gathered to listen to Paul and Barnabas, the Jews are "filled with jealousy and with violent abuse contradicted what Paul said."

But Paul and Barnabas continue to speak out boldly. They turn to the Gentiles, who are delighted to know that they, too, are worthy of eternal life. The Jews continue to

persecute Paul and Barnabas "and expelled them from their territory." Paul and Barnabas shake the dust from their feet and resume their journey: filled with joy and the Holy Spirit, their mission to take the word of the Lord to the ends of the earth continues.

Paul and Barnabas teach an important lesson: despite being persecuted, they remain faithful to their call to share the new life that can be found in Christ's resurrection. They are filled with the Spirit and, thus, are strengthened to continue their mission. Where do you get your strength when you are feeling discouraged? How can you embrace the resurrection of our Lord and share that Good News with others?
