FROM THE PASTOR

Cardinal Robert Prevost (age 69), now Pope Leo XIV, was elected the first pope born in the United States just after last weekend's bulletin went to publication. I'm excited that he chose the name Leo because 125 years ago, Pope Leo XIII (the previous Leo) battled the negative effects of the Industrial Revolution on the poor. He laid down the basis for the Church's social justice principles, which guidelines we still use today. In addition, he already stated that he wants a synodal church that is "close to the people who suffer." I believe these are clear messages from the new pope of the direction he hopes to take. I also like the fact that he ran a diocese and religious order so he knows all about administration and spreadsheets! We pray that he is a spiritual leader, a person of vision, who can build upon the legacy of his immediate predecessors in such a way as to meet the challenges of the present moment.
