FAMILY FAITH Orientation for New Families (Grades 1-8)

When is the Orientation? Monday, June 16 at either 10:00am or 7:00pm in the Community Room.

Who Needs to Attend? Parents who will be participating in our faith formation program for the first time this September. This could be parents who are new to the parish with children in grades 1-8, or parents with an incoming first grader who are entering the Family Faith program for the first time. You will need to register as a parishioner with the parish if you haven't vet done so. You may register your family online on the parish website (under the "About" tab).

When Does Online Registration Begin for Families who were in the program last year? Tuesday, July 1

FIRST EUCHARIST Parent Orientation (usually grade 2)

Who's eligible to enter our First Eucharist Preparation Program so they can receive First Eucharist in 2026? Children who have been baptized AND have already completed one year of religious education or family faith (here or elsewhere). Most of the eligible children will be entering 2nd grade in September. These families must also register for our Family Faith Program.

When is the First Eucharist Parent Orientation? Monday, June 16 at either 10:30am or 7:30pm in the Community Room. No need to bring your child. You must attend the Orientation to receive the necessary paperwork to register for First Eucharist Preparation. This paperwork will NOT be available online. Contact Patty Dodwell at ext. 832 with any ?s.

CONFIRMATION PREPARATION (a 2-year process)

Please be aware that your child cannot begin YEAR 1 of Confirmation Preparation in 9th grade unless he or she has completed religious education or family faith & jr. high faith formation covering grades one through eight inclusive (here or elsewhere).

Students beginning YEAR 1 of Confirmation Preparation (typically 9th grade) will have an orientation at their first Youth Ministry Gathering on Sunday, Sept. 21, 2025; a parent orientation will take place at the same time as the teen orientation. Effective July 1, you will be able to register online for Year 1.

Students eligible to begin year 2 of Confirmation Preparation who did not attend an orientation this past week must contact Craig at ext. 819 to receive the registration paperwork, which is NOT available online.





From Our Justice & Peace Ministry

The Federal Budget appropriations process is currently underway. The House Budget Committee passed the "Big Beautiful Bill" which includes cuts to Medicaid and SNAP. The final determination by Congress will affect many individuals, seniors, disabled, and families who are most vulnerable. The Bread for the World letters which we sent several weeks ago spoke to some of the programs (WIC and SNAP). It is urgent that you again contact your representatives to remind them of the impact on poor and vulnerable families of any budget cuts to Medicaid, SNAP and other family support programs.
