Lessons from the Camino for Transitions During Lent

As some of you may know, I had the privilege of making three pilgrimages along the Camino de Santiago (the Way of St. James) for a combined 500 miles; hiking the ancient routes stretching across Europe and converging at the tomb of Saint James in Santiago de Compostela in northwest Spain. The gift of the Camino keeps giving long after the experience is over. As we face transitions in our lives of all kinds, I humbly offer Seven Lessons for your prayerful consideration or quiet moments:

- 1) Invite trusted friends to be with you through uncertainty.
- 2) Look back and accept you have changed from the last major transition.
- 3) Cherish the beauty of "not knowing" and trusting God explicitly
- 4) Remain deeply grateful for the people God sends into your life unexpectedly with a customized message for you.
- 5) Be attentive to what nature teaches when you feel down and lonely
- 6) Be open for a new creative period in your life after dealing with loss, varied changes, and "whatever."
- 7) Pray and honor your "goodbyes" and ready yourself to be better at welcoming all.

Weekly Justice Challenge



Today's Gospel addresses the story of the man born blind. The Jews blamed his parents and their sins for his condition, but Jesus taught a different message—that God doesn't punish people for things which aren't their fault. Your challenge this week is to look at how you judge others and yourself. Do you look at people's actions through the lens of a loving God? Do you give others the benefit of the doubt? And are you gentle with yourself? Do you forgive yourself when you mess up, trusting in a God who forgives infinitely? God is the arbiter of justice, and we are called to trust in God's judgment, which ultimately is so much more merciful than human judgment. Place the world in God's hands this week, and stop yourself from judging.
