

At Jacob's Well

Waterford crystal comes from the hands of skilled craftsmen, and its claret decanter is a prized possession, for it requires the services of four skilled craftsmen & seven assistants. Yet, the purpose of any decanter is usually to hold a fine liquor, an aged wine, or cool well water.

In today's Gospel, we encounter a chore-laden Samaritan woman doing another daily chore. She is seeking to lower her bucket for some cool well water. She did not carry on her head a Waterford claret decanter. Instead, she carried the clay water jar of her times.

Her original plans are blocked when she meets a tired preacher who looks like he needs a drink desperately. This man does not have a bucket to draw some cool refreshing water for his parched lips. "Give me a drink," he asks the woman. Little did the woman know that after her chat with the wandering "Sir" she would be refreshed like she never was before.

The Samaritan woman is drained from the lack of real intimacy in her life. Her inner reservoir is all dried up. She has given and given, but men have taken advantage of her. Five husbands have passed through her life. She has decided not to marry, but to live with a man. The man at the well is like no man she has ever met before. This man makes her feel

special. This man does not put her down for being a member of a mixed race. For once in her life, a man is taking her seriously; she is not just an object for his pleasure. She genuinely feels like a fellow human being in the presence of this unusually sensitive and caring man.

For all of us, the Samaritan woman has become that person refreshed by Jesus. She is our hope that we will always find refreshment in our relationship with the Lord. It is part of life that we will suffer through some tough relationships. Those who have lived through the pain of divorce understand the lack of self-esteem which accompanies a broken relationship. Jesus gave the woman at the well back her self-esteem and self-respect.

We stand with the Samaritan woman and we need to leave something behind at the well. We need to leave behind all that drains our self-esteem and self-respect. Then, our Lord, who loves us no matter who we are, will refresh our parched spirit. Yes, the man at the well is never quick to judge, no matter what our past may be. Allow the Jesus of Lent to hit the stone of your inner wellspring. Then you too can be the decanter which holds something more precious than any Waterford crystal.
