

Weekly Justice Challenge

Today we celebrate the mystery that is the Most Holy Trinity, three Persons yet one God. The Trinity exists in perfect communion and community as Father, Son and Spirit. God doesn't just give perfect love-God is Love, and that love reveals itself in the relationship of Father, Son and Spirit. Your challenge this week is to make the connection between love and justice. As Pope Benedict wrote in Caritas in Veritate, "Love - caritas - is an extraordinary force which leads people to opt for courageous and generous engagement in the field of justice and peace. It is a force that has its origin in God, Eternal Love and Absolute Truth." Reflect this week on the following questions (as individuals and as families): "How does God's love for us compel us to take action to fight injustice? Who needs our love the most this week-in the family, in our community, and in our world? How can we share our love? Is it through service, advocacy, financial support or something else?" Select one way of living justice through the lens of love-and do it!
