FAMILY FAITH & JUNIOR HIGH Families registering for these two programs must be registered parishioners. You may register your family to be parishioners online on the parish website (under the "About" tab). *Contact Marilou Tenazas at ext. 815 with any questions.*

FIRST EUCHARIST Preparation

Children who have been baptized AND have already completed one year of religious education or family faith (here or elsewhere) or are in Catholic school, are eligible for the program (most will be entering 2nd grade in September). *Contact Patty Dodwell at ext. 832 with any questions.*

YEAR 1 CONFIRMATION Preparation

is a 2-year process which usually begins in 9th grade, **PROVIDED, HOWEVER**, that the student has completed faith formation/religious education covering grades 1-8 inclusive (here or elsewhere). *Contact Craig Johnson at ext. 819 with any questions.*

YEAR 2 CONFIRMATION Preparation

Orientation - Students eligible to begin YEAR 2 of Confirmation preparation were required to come to one of the orientation meetings with at least one parent. Registration for YEAR 2 of Confirmation preparation is NOT available online.

DON'T BE FOOLED

It has come to our attention that scammers are impersonating our priests sending texts &/or emails in their names saying there is some sort of emergency and then asking for money, gift cards etc. or for personal info such as your phone no. These types of communications would NEVER be sent from Fr. Anthony or Fr. Richard (or any staff member). These scammers are very clever and expect that your first instinct will be to respond to a request from a priest that you know. Just delete the text or email - **don't "reply" or click on any links!**

Weekly Justice Challenge

We mark Independence Day every July to celebrate our freedom as a democratic nation.
