EMMA'S REFLECTION ON OUR YOUNG ADULT MISSION TRIP TO JAMAICA

It is impossible to describe exactly the experience of serving at Jacob's Ladder. There is something very special about that place and its people that must be experienced for oneself. However, as I reflect on my time there with our team, as well as my time at Presentation more broadly, one verse comes to mind to share a taste of our time: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light" (Mt 11:28-30, from the Gospel on July 5). This being the Gospel on our first full day of mission in Jamaica was a particular gift of Providence for my heart. I had been studying, writing, and praying for months about the Lord's Most Sacred Heart, trying to learn how to unite my own heart to His. Then, Jacob's Ladder, the residents, workers, and team members helped me learn not only what is the Most Sacred Heart, but how to abide therein.

The reason Mustard Seed Communities is so special, at least one of the reasons, is that everyone there lives the love of the Most Sacred Heart. In His Heart, Christ feels the fullness of His Passion. That Heart that beats for and with us beats always with equal and immense suffering and joy: the suffering of the Cross and the joy of the Resurrection. At Mustard Seed, we encounter those who are suffering, but never display their sorrow. Encountering those at Mustard Seed is a paradox in a large way: they are men and women who experience great suffering, yet they never despair. I learned firsthand the great lesson that to encounter those who suffer is to encounter real joy. To paraphrase Fr. Anthony from the reflection on our final night, on the

grounds of Jacob's Ladder there is a relationship, albeit mysterious, where suffering and joy coalesce. The joy of human dignity triumphs over the suffering of physical and intellectual disabilities. How is this? Why is it so enlightening and special to live among the residents? Because it is a reflection of the life available to us in the Heart of Christ. When bartering the price of a beaded bracelet with Sandy, a woman who is wheelchair bound due to cerebral palsy; when receiving a hug from Lee-Chin, a lovable young man with down syndrome; when visiting with Lincoln, bedbound as a result of progressed cerebral palsy, and Shauna, who travels from one end of the property to the other to visit with Lincoln as well; when we hug, converse, or simply hold the hands of the residents, we get to encounter love in such a simple, generous, life-giving way. We had the opportunity to come to know the raw love of the Heart of God through these individuals.

That is why we are already counting down the days until we can go back to our new family. Because life in the Heart is exactly as Christ promises it will be: a life where burdens are light and where there is rest for our souls.

Thank you to Fr. Anthony, Tom and Nancy Mierswa, and Marianne Strayton without whom this trip could not have been possible. Thank you to everyone who generously supported our fundraising efforts and especially to those who prayed with and for us. Your kindness has helped all of us draw nearer to the Sacred Heart, allowing us to experience and share the true and resilient joy and peace of Christ.

Weekly Justice Challenge



On August 7 & 9, we mark the bombings of Nagasaki and Hiroshima during World War II. Today we have nuclear weapons which are much more devastating than the atomic bombs dropped on Japan almost 70 years ago. Our U.S. Bishops have written courageously about nuclear war. Applying the Catholic Church's teaching about just war, which has evolved over the past two thousand years, the bishops have concluded that they cannot justify the use of nuclear weapons. Your challenge this week is to look at how you can contribute to a peaceful world so that the threat of nuclear war is made remote and unimaginable. How are you a peacemaker in your home? At school or at work? In your community? In how you engage in civic life? What is one thing you can do this week to make our world safer for everyone?
