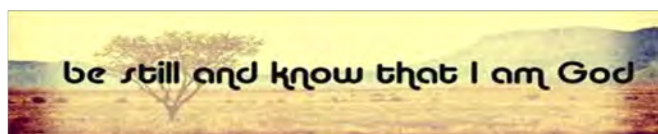

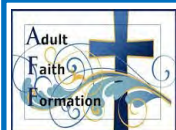
Presentation Ambassadors Needed!
