**Season of Creation - Immersion in Living Water
The Earth is a Shared Vineyard**

In today's Gospel, Jesus shares the Parable of the Workers in the Vineyard (Matthew 20:1-16a). We hear of a generous landowner who pays all of his laborers a day's wage, even the ones who started long after the original laborers began. During this Season of Creation, we are reminded that our Earth is like a shared vineyard we are working on, and God's grace flows through it like Living Water to sustain all living things. In his letter, *Laudato Si'*, Pope Francis highlights that access to safe, clean water is a basic human right because it is essential for life. Just as the vineyard owner cares for every single worker, God calls us to care for every part of creation to ensure its life-giving resources are shared fairly. Let the Living Water that sustains us also inspire us to share this gift equally, ensuring that no one is left thirsty.

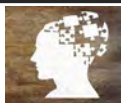

Weekly Justice Challenge



This Sunday's Gospel challenges us to look at people on the bottom of the economic ladder with the heart of justice and mercy that God has towards them.

Before getting caught up in the seeming unfairness of the situation where those who worked longer got paid the same as those who worked fewer hours, what if we looked with compassion on the plight of those who want to work and are willing to work but don't have the opportunities that others do? The parable doesn't say the workers stood idle all day because they were lazy, it says they were idle because no one hired them. Maybe they were older, or not as physically strong, or they didn't speak the language of those doing the hiring, or there simply were too more people looking for work that day, so they waited in vain to try to earn enough to feed their families. What if Jesus was speaking to the unfairness of the economic situation that left some people out of work? This week, keep your eyes open for people who live paycheck to paycheck and for the unemployed or under-employed. Ask God to give you compassion and understanding for their plight, and to move your heart to action on their behalf.
